Long Beach Unified School District is the third largest district in the State of California, serving a diverse student population. The Head Start program is funded to serve 1,552 children and families in 24 centers throughout the Long Beach Unified School District boundaries.

LBUSD Head Start program is accepting applications for the position of Head Start day-to-day Substitute Teacher in the Head Start preschool program and the Early Head Start program.

Requirements:

- Hold an AA Degree or higher (BA/BS or MA/MS) in Child Development/Early Childhood Education or related field, inclusive of 24 ECE units.
- Hold and maintain a valid California Child Development Teacher Permit.
- Hold and maintain the 16 hours certification in Pediatric First Aid, Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation, and Health & Safety (including the Nutrition Component) upon hire or within 30 days of employment.
- Have 3 units of infant/toddler coursework in order to teach in the Early Head Start Program.
- Required vaccination for Pertussis and Measles prior to hire. Influenza vaccine is required annually during the flu season.
